A.C. SOMALI PREMIER – FEMALE

GR. PR. JONES PR. ADTRESH HALI – (63c) (9.6.03) Blue girl with a lovely temperament. Moderate wedge shaped head, ears set well apart, slight tips, large bright almond shaped eyes, dark surround and light spectacles, gentle contours to brow and cheeks, slight nose break. Well developed body, long legs and oval feet with toe tufts, tail well furnished and long. Dense soft coat of a good blue, ticking even, spine line down back carrying on to tail, warm mushroom base coat, mushroom tummy and chest, head marking, heels and toe tuft blue - gentle to handle.

RES. STABLES GR. CH.& PR. AMORES OPHELIA FIZKIN - (63s) (14.2.03) Mature well made Usual Silver lady, well padded tummy, long limbs, neat oval feet. dense soft coat, well ticked in black, spine line down to tail, black tip. Silver base, chest, tummy, and inner back legs. Black toe tufts and facial markings. Moderate balanced wedge shaped head, ears set well apart, slight rise from nose to forehead, firm chin, almond shaped bright eyes, black rimmed with light spectacles – friendly temperament.

SORREL SOMALI ADULT - FEMALE

1ST. CC & BOB – BULLIVANTS BARANCHRI HATHOR – (63a) (21.4.09) Lovely Sorrel wearing a coat of rich copper, warm apricot to base, ticking cinnamon, heels, ear tips and facial markings cinnamon. Apricot to chest, tummy and inner legs. Moderate wedge shaped head, face showing a typical smiley expression, large eyes set nicely apart, spectacles, eye lines, gentle rise from nose bridge to forehead, slight break to nose in profile. Elegant body standing on long legs, tail long tapering towards tip – lovely natured girl.

USUAL SOMALI KITTEN – FEMALE

1ST. & BOB MELIA SUPATOFT TIKA MASALA – (7.7.09) Most attractive kitten although she was a bit of a madam, but handled alright. Head showing good development, ears large set well apart, broad based, crescent shape from behind, Good inner furnishings. Bright large eyes obliquely set a pleasing hazel, slight nose break, good chin. Golden brown soft kitten coat, ticking developing over shoulders, apricot to base, hocks almost complete, facial markings and tail tip black – lovely youngster.

2ND. BURNS SOMANTIKKS ISADORA-BELLE – (20.9.09) Promising youngster starting to go through the teenage stage. Coat going a touch harsh on lower back, but black ticking over shoulders and coming in on sides, black to tail tip, hocks not yet complete. Head shape a nice wedge, ears large and pricked, broad based, eyes oval, with spectacles and dark surround, muzzle a little narrow. Golden brown coat, the ticking black, chest, tummy and legs a nice apricot, broken necklace – lovely natured lass.

AOC (EX. SILVER) SOMALI KITTEN – MALE

1ST. & BOB FRANSIS NAINASUS HURRICANE – (63c) (0.11.09) Not a lot of the hurricane about this Blue lad, he was asleep when we got to him and promptly went to sleep when we put him back in his pen! He had a lovely coat soft and dense, flat over his spine, base a warm mushroom, ticking even blue no sign of any grey to roots, dark outline to eyes with lighter surround, slight lines at edge of eyes, blue hocks and toe tufts, warm mushroom tummy, chest and inner legs. Ears set high on well developed skull, gentle break to nose in profile, chin just needing a touch more strength, bright almond shaped eyes. Already developing a firm body, legs long with oval feet, tail tapers needing to fill out a little – really laid back lad.

FEMALE

1ST. POINTINGS BRIZLINCOAT BLUE CHANTRELL – (63c) (11.9.09) Pretty Blue baby wearing a dense coat of a mid even blue, ticking developing over shoulders, undercoat a pale mushroom. Bright smiley expression, ears set high on wedge shaped head, slight nose break, good chin, eyes large and almond shaped, dark blue surround and lighter spectacles, whisker spots. Body lithe and well formed, long legs, blue hocks, feet oval with blue toe tufts, spine line coming in carrying down to tail which was in balance to body - gentle lass so nice to handle.

2ND. WATTS EMANAN CHOCOLATE SENSATION – (63b) (29.7.09) This youngster was very much at the teenage stage in her development, length to body, long legs, feet oval with tufts. Head a little narrow, slight break to nose, ears high and wide apart, bright expressive almond shaped eyes of a warm hazel, needing a stronger chin to develop. Lovely coat of a warm chestnut, apricot base and dark chocolate ticking, hock, ear tips, facial markings chocolate, tummy, inner legs and trousers warm apricot, tail in proportion, well furnished with dark chocolate to tip – friendly girl who just needs time to develop.

3RD. COONEYS TAGLIER CHAMPAGNE TRUFFLE – (63b) (31.8.09) Chocolate girl with a lovely expression, bright hazel almond set eyes, moderate wedge to head, she was very shy and shaking she kept her ears flared, gentle break to nose, firm chin. Length to lithe body, long legs, paws neat with slight tufts. Coat although soft was rather open on her back, overall a good chocolate, darker over back, base coat apricot. Warm light apricot to chest, tummy and inner legs. Eyes surrounded by dark rings and lighter spectacles, lines from side of eyes, ticking moving down from shoulders, her tail was bushy and slightly tapered, unfortunately she has a fault at the end (confirmed by the duty vet), otherwise apart from being very shy she was a lovely youngster.

AC SIBERIAN OR TURKISH VANKEDISI NOVICE ADULT

1ST. BAXTERS ESAYA BWYCHING-ELMARLAY – Black Smoke Siberian with a super coat, harsher black top coat with full clear white undercoat, nice frill and full trousers, tail in balance again showing good contrasts. Strong head with lovely eyes, cheeks widening. Solid body with real “heft” strong limbs and big feet – lovely natured lad.

AC SOMALI MAIDEN KITTEN

1ST. JAMES BRIZLINCOAT CASSANDRA – Very friendly Sorrel girl her coat was a rich copper, apricot base and well ticked in cinnamon. Smiley expression, ears set high, wide based, bright hazel almond shaped eyes, very slight nose break, firm chin – friendly lass.

AV VETERAN NEUTER

1ST. MELIAS CH. & GRPR. ADMILSH ASTROKINI NEXUS – Chocolate girl in lovely condition, coat dense, soft well ticked in dark chocolate, apricot base, tummy, chest and trousers, dark spine line running to tail tip. Smiley expression, bright eyes of an almond shape, ears set high and wide at base, strength to muzzle – lovely nature.

1ST. & MC WEBBS PURRCY – Solid chubby Ginger and White boy in lovely condition, strong boned, well padded tummy. Big head, fat cheeks, large expressive eyes. thick coat with lots of tabby markings to head and back, a nice rich red, white on face and paws, thick tail – laid back lad.
